Our hospital is over 250 years old. Today, we are Denmark's leading hospital for patients needing highly specialized treatment and care




#1 Integrated play

Reason: We believe play can help promote healing and help the families better get through their experiences at the hospital




Our ambition is to integrate play in 3 different domains at Children's Hospital Copenhagen




The building design is already on a structural level 'playfully logical', rethinking the traditional hospital typology
